



My Crochet Advent Calendar is back for a fourth edition! English instructions will be provided in pdf format – here is what to expect.

We will start on Monday November 27th 2017, using the same system as last year. From Monday to Friday, I will publish tutorials for a mini crochet project to make in 5 steps. Saturdays and Sundays are for the special offers, valid only during 24 hours (from 00h01 am to 23h59 pm, Paris time).

Special offers will not be translated to English, and the coupon codes can be used only in the French shop – but feel free to check out the blog and email me if you're interested.

### **This year's theme: Christmas baubles!**

We are going to decorate baubles using hook and yarn.

For each week's project you will need a Christmas bauble to decorate. I use baubles that are approx 6 cm/2.25" across (bought years ago in a Swedish furniture store that I think you have already heard of).

You can use any Christmas bauble of comparable size, found in your Christmas decorations box... except glass baubles which can break easily and will be too dangerous to manipulate for these projects.

Coloured baubles, transparent baubles, other baubles ... the choice is yours, but know that the bauble you use will peek through and remain partly visible.

For our projects, we will mainly use fingering weight yarn (small quantities – leftovers will work perfectly) and a 3 mm hook (US C-2 or D-3). You can improvise of course (and I might also do so myself, all details are not yet completely worked out), but this is where we'll start!

The daily tutorial will be published only on my blog, with a link to the pdf with the English translation. You are very welcome to [join the Facebook group created for the calendar](#) – the links to the daily blog posts will be published there. All blog posts linked to the Advent Calendar will be categorized as "dec2017" – you can find them in the "Categories" menu in the right-hand column on the blog.

The Advent Calendar blog posts will be published every day from November 27th to December 24th 2017.

Each finished project from the calendar of which a photo is published in the Facebook group or sent to me via email ([annette@annettepetavy.com](mailto:annette@annettepetavy.com)) gives you an entry in the prize drawing. By publishing or sending me your photo, you authorize me to republish it – these publications will only be done in connection to the calendar, of course.

To enter the prize drawing you must send me your photo or photos at the latest on January 7th 2018 – so you can use any time off during the Christmas holiday to complete your projects if you don't have the time during Advent.
